The History of the Funeral Cooperative of Ottawa (FCO)

The Funeral Co-operative of Ottawa was established and incorporated in 2010 and opened its doors in October 2013. We are a full-service funeral facility, licensed by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario. We operate on a not-for-profit basis only. As a Co-operative, we operate democratically, with a volunteer board of directors overseeing the direction of the enterprise. We promise no pressure or upselling, making the final decision truly yours. All our staff are salaried, and not on commission, further reducing the incentive of upselling members.

Membership

Becoming a member of the Funeral Co-operative of Ottawa, means being part of our community. Membership includes receiving regular valuable information by email, being able to volunteer your time with us (though this is not mandatory). A membership is only \$35.00 (taxes included), and is a one-time, non-refundable, non-transferrable fee.

Member's Discount

Members receive a 10% discount off all the Funeral Co-operative's Services (not including merchandise or third-party and/or disbursements). Discounts will only be applied at the time of signing either a pre-need or at-need contract with our co-operative. *A membership must be purchased 30 days prior to signing a contract to be eligible for a discount at the time of need. Pre-arrangement contracts are not subject to a 30-day waiting period.*

Payment, Financing and Funding

Unless otherwise specified, our minimum deposit for services and merchandise is \$3000 and is due upon signing an at-need contract (when a death has occurred). All cash disbursements are due upon signing. The full balance is due by the end of 10 days of signing. Beyond 10 days, interest will be charged at a rate of 2% per month, which is equivalent to 24% per annum. Payment for "at-need" services may be made by cash, cheque or bank draft, debit, and by most major credit cards. Additional information about funding, payment and financing options is available on request.

Funding a Funeral Prepaid Contract - Trust

For your convenience and peace of mind, we will place your funds in trust with Guaranteed Funeral Deposits of Canada. It will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled. The Funeral Co-operative of Ottawa will use that interest to fund the difference in price between the time the contract was signed and the time the contract is fulfilled. Any interest accrued more than the at-need prices will be refunded.

Essential Services

Staff and Professional Services **\$650.00**

Licensed Funeral Director available 24 hours a day, initial contact, arrangement conference, coordination of details at the place of death, consultation, information and responsibility for transfer details, arrangements for final disposition (not including fees for final disposition), recording government vital statistics, licensing fees, accounting and legal expenses, professional services required for the maintenance of a licensed funeral establishment.

Documentation and Administration **\$495.00**

Completion and filing of all documents needed to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation and provision of 20 Proof of Death Certificates issued by The Funeral Co-operative of Ottawa, Executor's Toolkit for estate settlement purposes. Administration and clerical assistance preparing all disbursement cheques, attend to the necessary details in connection with the arrangements for cremation or burial. Arrange for the attendance of coroner if required. Assist in developing media notices, providing clergy record.

Transfer of Deceased **\$485.00**

Transfer of the deceased from the place of death (within a 40 km radius of our facility) using an unmarked van. An additional charge of 2.25/km will apply when the transfer is outside of the 40 km radius of our facility one way.

Sheltering **\$195.00**

Facilities used to shelter, minimally prepare, or embalm the body. Biohazardous waste management and environmental fees are included.

Basic Preparation of Remains (*as requested*) **\$250.00**

Topical disinfection and minimal restoration, which includes washing, dressing, and casketing of the remains when embalming is not selected for identification purposes.

Administration Vehicle **\$125.00**

Vehicle used in obtaining all required documentation such as a provincial burial permit and coroner's certificate for cremation when required.

Transfer to Crematorium **\$350.00**

Transportation from the funeral home to the crematorium, when required. Use of an unmarked van, within the 50 km radius of the funeral home. Includes return of cremated remains to funeral home.

Embalming of the Remains **\$695.00**

*****Requires Sheltering***

Embalming is the process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary disinfection of the body for funeral purposes. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs. Dressing, application of cosmetics and professional hairdressing are included.

Additional Staff for Initial Transfer of Remains **\$75.00**

A charge applies for each transportation request. Includes unmarked vehicle, required equipment and one staff member. Additional fees may apply if transport of remains is during nonbusiness hours, weekend, holiday or from a location where additional staffing is required. If weight is over 200 lbs. an additional fee may apply due to additional staffing requirements. Additional staffing \$75.00 each per hour (one hr min.).

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains	\$350.00
By law in Ontario, a funeral home has a right to charge a deposit for cremated remains, which gets returned to the legal representative when they claim the cremated remains. After one year, the Funeral Co-operative of Ottawa has the right to inter the remains at a cemetery in common ground, at which point the deposit is non-refundable. Should an authorized representative wish to retrieve the cremated remains, it is at their expense.

Additional Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and paid for on your behalf by the funeral home. You are expected to pay for these items at the time of the funeral arrangements.

Crematorium Fee: Fees set by the crematorium of choice to perform the act of cremation.

Coroner's Fee: Fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows for the cremation of human remains to take place. This fee is set by the Office of the Chief Coroner of Ontario.

Municipal Death Registration: This is the fee charged by the local municipality to register a death.

Clergy Honorarium: This is an amount paid to the clergy for their services.

Media Notices: Charge for the death notice in any newspaper as selected.

Catering: Food provided for the purpose of a reception. Cost will be depending on the menu selected.

Musicians: Fee paid to a person performing these services. The amount is set by the musician.

Cemetery Fees: Fees set by the cemetery of choice.
